## A BILL

To require the removal of United States Armed Forces from Saudi Arabia.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Strained Partnership
- 5 Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. REMOVAL OF UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES
- 7 FROM SAUDI ARABIA.
- 8 (a) Removal.—All United States Armed Forces and
- 9 equipment, including Patriot missile batteries and the
- 10 Terminal High Altitude Area Defense (THAAD) system,
- 11 shall be removed from the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia by

- 1 not later than 90 days after the date of the enactment
- 2 of this Act.
- 3 (b) Relocation of Equipment.—Patriot missile
- 4 batteries and the Terminal High Altitude Area Defense
- 5 system relocated pursuant to subsection (a) shall, to the
- 6 extent practicable, be relocated to another location or loca-
- 7 tions in the Middle East, with the priority mission of pro-
- 8 tecting United States Armed Forces.
