## A BILL

To provide for the rescheduling of marijuana into schedule III of the Controlled Substances Act.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. RESCHEDULING OF MARIJUANA.
- 4 Notwithstanding section 201 and subsections (a) and
- 5 (b) of section 202 of the Controlled Substances Act (21
- 6 U.S.C. 811, 812) respecting the scheduling of controlled
- 7 substances, the Attorney General of the United States
- 8 shall, by order not later than 60 days after the date of
- 9 enactment of this section, transfer marijuana (for pur-

- 1 poses of this Act given the same meaning given the term
- 2 "marihuana" in section 102 of such Act) from schedule
- 3 I of such Act to schedule III of such Act.
