"Section 14. Termination. [This act] terminates June 30,~~2015~~ ~~2021~~ 2027."

Section 3. Section 1, Chapter 292, Laws of 2015, is amended to read:

"Section 14. Termination. [This act] terminates June 30,~~2015~~ ~~2021~~ 2027."

Section 4. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
