A BILL

To prohibit the use of Federal funds to carry out or support
a program that distributes hypodermic needles or syringes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Mandatory End to
5 Needle Distribution in Our Neighborhoods Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON USE OF FUNDS FOR HYPODERMIC**
7 **NEEDLES OR SYRINGES.**

8 After the end of the 30-day period beginning on the
9 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Health and
10 Human Services and the Director of the Centers for Dis-

1 ease Control and Prevention may not use Federal funds
2 to carry out or support a program that distributes a hypo-
3 dermic needle or syringe to an individual for the use of
4 an illegal drug. Nothing in the preceding sentence shall
5 be construed as applying with respect to the lawful use
6 of a prescription drug.
