A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing January 21, 2020, as Tourism, Hospitality, and Arts Day at the state capitol to
- 2 foster awareness and convey the value of these industries to our state; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Economic Development and its partners will
- 4 celebrate Tourism, Hospitality, and Arts Day at the state capitol on January 21, 2020, and
- 5 recognize the innumerable tourism industry professionals across the state; and
- 6 WHEREAS, this annual gathering of tourism industry professionals is an event that
- 7 acknowledges the importance of these industries, celebrates the prior year, and looks to the
- 8 year ahead; and
- 9 WHEREAS, in 2018, travel and tourism to Georgia generated more than \$66.3 billion in total
- 10 tourism output, including direct, indirect, and induced impact, which represents a 4.7 percent
- 11 increase; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Georgia's tourism industry supported more than 478,000 jobs, directly or
- indirectly, for travel and other industries; and
- 14 WHEREAS, in 2018, travel and tourism directly generated over \$3.4 billion in state and local
- 15 tax revenue; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Georgia welcomed a record 111.7 million visitors in 2018, which generated
- 17 \$36.9 billion in spending revenue; and
- 18 WHEREAS, tourism, hospitality, and arts serve as economic engines that collectively and
- 19 individually impact every county, city, and community in Georgia; they are critical for
- 20 attracting and supporting new businesses and for expanding existing ones; and
