3 SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON ASSISTANCE TO PAKISTAN.

4 No amounts appropriated or otherwise made avail-5 able to the Department of State or the United States

Agency for International Development may be made avail able as assistance to the Government of Pakistan.

3 SEC. 2. REQUIRED TRANSFERS TO THE HIGHWAY TRUST 4 FUND.

5 (a) DEPARTMENT OF STATE.—Upon receipt of ap6 propriations for the balance of fiscal year 2018, the Sec7 retary of State shall transfer \$1,280,000,000 to the High8 way Trust Fund.

9 (b) UNITED STATES AGENCY FOR INTERNATIONAL 10 DEVELOPMENT.—Upon receipt of appropriations for the 11 balance of fiscal year 2018, the Administrator of the 12 United States Agency for International Development shall 13 transfer \$852,000,000 to the Highway Trust Fund.
