A BILL

To amend title 23, United States Code, to allow food concessions at State-owned interstate rest areas.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. REST AREAS.

(a) FOOD CONCESSIONS.—Section 111(b)(2) of title

23, United States Code, is amended—

(1) by redesignating subparagraphs (D) and

(E) as subparagraphs (E) and (F), respectively; and

(2) by inserting after subparagraph (C) the fol-

1	"(D) concessions, including restaurants,
2	food services, and convenience stores;".
3	(b) Tax Revenues.—Section 111(b)(4) of such title
4	is amended by adding at the end the following: "Notwith-
5	standing the preceding sentence, a State may use revenues
6	received from concessions under paragraph (2)(D) to sup-
7	port any program authorized under this title.".
