A BILL

To amend title 23, United States Code, to allow food concessions at State-owned interstate rest areas.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REST AREAS.**

4 (a) FOOD CONCESSIONS.—Section 111(b)(2) of title
5 23, United States Code, is amended—

6 (1) by redesignating subparagraphs (D) and
7 (E) as subparagraphs (E) and (F), respectively; and

8 (2) by inserting after subparagraph (C) the fol-
9 lowing:

1 “(D) concessions, including restaurants,
2 food services, and convenience stores;”.

3 (b) TAX REVENUES.—Section 111(b)(4) of such title
4 is amended by adding at the end the following: “Notwith-
5 standing the preceding sentence, a State may use revenues
6 received from concessions under paragraph (2)(D) to sup-
7 port any program authorized under this title.”.
