3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stadiums Operating
5 under New Guidance Act” or the “SONG Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REVISION OF SECTION 91.145 OF TITLE 14, CODE OF**
2 **FEDERAL REGULATIONS.**

3 Not later than one year after the enactment of this
4 Act, the Secretary of Transportation, acting through the
5 Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration,
6 shall revise section 91.145 of title 14, Code of Federal
7 Regulations (or any successor regulation), such that the
8 term “sporting” does not limit the types of major events
9 described in such section.

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
