## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 6 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to state
- 2 health planning and development, so as to provide for an exemption for integrated
- 3 ambulatory surgery centers from certificate of need requirements; to provide for a definition;
- 4 to provide for conditions; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
- 5 other purposes.

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## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Chapter 6 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to state health
- 9 planning and development, is amended in Code Section 31-6-2, relating to definitions, by
- 10 adding a new paragraph to read as follows:
- 11 "(21.1) 'Integrated ambulatory surgery center' means a single specialty neuromuscular
- orthopedic ambulatory surgical center that is an essential and fundamental supporting
- component of a comprehensive sports medicine complex operated together with an
- 14 <u>integrated athletic training and medical educational facility for youth, amateur, and</u>
- professional athletes; ancillary services, including physical therapy and diagnostic
- 16 <u>imaging; medical research activities; and physician training and education for sports</u>

medicine, with a minimum total campus area of 400,000 square feet."

18 SECTION 2.

- 19 Said chapter is further amended in subsection (a) of Code Section 31-6-47, relating to
- 20 exemptions from chapter, by striking "and" at the end of paragraph (25), by replacing the
- 21 period at the end of paragraph (26) with "; and", and by adding a new paragraph to read as
- 22 follows:

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- 23 "(27) An integrated ambulatory surgery center that:
- 24 (A) Provides uncompensated indigent and charity care in an amount equal to or greater
- 25 <u>than 5 percent of its adjusted gross revenue; and</u>

26	(B) Provides annual reports in the same manner and in accordance with Code
27	Section 31-6-70.
28	Noncompliance with any condition of this paragraph shall result in a monetary penalty
29	in the amount of the difference between the services which the center is required to
30	provide and the amount actually provided and may be subject to revocation of its
31	exemption status by the department for repeated failure to pay any fines or moneys due
32	to the department or for repeated failure to produce data as required by Code
33	Section 31-6-70 after notice to the exemption holder and a fair hearing pursuant to
34	Chapter 13 of Title 50, the 'Georgia Administrative Procedure Act.'"

35 SECTION 3.

36 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
