- 6 Postal Service located at 123 Bridgeton Pike in Mullica

- 1 Hill, New Jersey, shall be known and designated as the
- 2 "James C. 'Billy' Johnson Post Office Building".
- 3 (b) References.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
- 4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
- 5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
- 6 be deemed to be a reference to the "James C. 'Billy' John-
- 7 son Post Office Building".
