A BILL

- To direct the Secretary of Homeland Security to extend the period of authorized stay for certain alien health care workers during the COVID-19 emergency period, and for other purposes.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Health Care Workforce
 - 5 Protection Act of 2020".

1	SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF AUTHORIZED STAY FOR CERTAIN
2	ALIEN HEALTH CARE WORKERS DURING
3	COVID-19 EMERGENCY PERIOD.
4	(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Homeland Secu-
5	rity shall extend the period of authorized stay for a cov-
6	ered alien healthcare worker until a date that is not earlier
7	than the date that is 60 days after the end of the emer-
8	gency period described in subparagraph (B) of section
9	1135(g)(1) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1320b-
10	5(g)(1)).
11	(b) COVERED ALIEN HEALTHCARE WORKER.—The
12	term "covered alien healthcare worker" means an alien—
13	(1) who was admitted to the United States
14	under section $101(a)(15)(H)(i)(b)$ to perform serv-
15	ices as a health care worker;
16	(2) who was serving in such capacity in the
17	United States for any period of time during the
18	emergency period described in subsection (a); and
19	(3) whose employment or work contract de-
20	scribed in paragraph (2) was terminated during such
21	period, except in the case that such employment or
22	contract was terminated for cause
