## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Nuclear Waste In-5 formed Consent Act".

### 6 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.

7 In this Act, the terms "affected Indian tribe", "af-8 fected unit of local government", "high-level radioactive waste", "repository", "Secretary", "spent nuclear fuel",
 and "unit of general local government" have the meanings
 given the terms in section 2 of the Nuclear Waste Policy
 Act of 1982 (42 U.S.C. 10101).

### 5 SEC. 3. CONSENT-BASED APPROVAL.

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary may not make an 7 expenditure from the Nuclear Waste Fund established 8 under section 302(c) of the Nuclear Waste Policy Act of 9 1982 (42 U.S.C. 10222(c)) for the costs of the activities 10 described in paragraphs (4) and (5) of section 302(d) of 11 that Act (42 U.S.C. 10222(d)) unless the Secretary has 12 entered into an agreement for a repository with—

13 (1) the Governor of the State in which the re-pository is proposed to be located;

15 (2) each affected unit of local government;

(3) any unit of general local government contiguous to the affected unit of local government if
spent nuclear fuel or high-level radioactive waste will
be transported through that unit of general local
government for disposal at the repository; and

21 (4) each affected Indian tribe.

(b) CONDITIONS ON AGREEMENT.—Any agreementfor a repository under this Act—

24 (1) shall be in writing and signed by all parties;

(2) shall be binding on the parties; and

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
