Pursuant to D.C. Official Code §2-352.02, I have enclosed, for consideration by the Council of the District of Columbia, the Council Contract Summary for the Agreement to Enter into a Long Term Subsidy Contract ("ALTSC") between the District of Columbia Housing Authority ("DCHA") and South Capitol Improvements, LLC (the "Owner"), a Proposed Resolution declaring an emergency to approve the ALTSC, and a Proposed Bill to approve the ALTSC.
