1 AN ACT concerning

2 University System of Maryland – Constituent Institutions – Alcohol and Drug 3 Addiction Recovery Program

FOR the purpose of requiring the Board of Regents of the University System of Maryland, 4 on a certain recommendation from the Chancellor, to establish general standards $\mathbf{5}$ 6 and guidelines for a collegiate recovery program to be implemented at the 7 constituent institutions; requiring the president of each constituent institution, in collaboration with faculty, staff, and students enrolled at the institution, to develop 8 9 and implement a collegiate recovery program tailored for the institution; requiring 10 that the program include certain features; defining a term; and generally relating to 11 a collegiate recovery program at constituent institutions of the University System of 12 Maryland.

1 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "COLLEGIATE RECOVERY PROGRAM" MEANS A 2 PROGRAM THAT PROVIDES SUPPORT AND SERVICES FOR STUDENTS RECOVERING 3 FROM ALCOHOL OR DRUG ADDICTION WHO ARE ENROLLED AT A CONSTITUENT 4 INSTITUTION.

5 (B) ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE CHANCELLOR, WHO SHALL 6 CONSULT WITH THE PRESIDENTS OF THE CONSTITUENT INSTITUTIONS, THE BOARD 7 OF REGENTS SHALL ESTABLISH GENERAL STANDARDS AND GUIDELINES FOR A 8 COLLEGIATE RECOVERY PROGRAM TO BE IMPLEMENTED AT THE CONSTITUENT 9 INSTITUTIONS.

10 (C) THE PRESIDENT OF EACH CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION, IN 11 COLLABORATION WITH FACULTY, STAFF, AND STUDENTS ENROLLED AT THE 12 INSTITUTION, SHALL DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT A COLLEGIATE RECOVERY 13 PROGRAM TAILORED FOR THE INSTITUTION THAT:

14(1)SATISFIES THE STANDARDS AND GUIDELINES ESTABLISHED BY15THE CHANCELLOR UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION; AND

16(2)ADDRESSES THE NEEDS OF STUDENTS AT THE INSTITUTION WHO17ARE RECOVERING FROM ALCOHOL OR DRUG ADDICTION.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 19 October 1, 2017.
