A BILL

To amend the Fair Housing Act to prohibit discrimination based on source of income or veteran status.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Fair Housing Improve-

5 ment Act of 2018".

6 SEC. 2. PROHIBITING HOUSING DISCRIMINATION BASED

7ON SOURCE OF INCOME OR VETERAN STA-8TUS.

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Fair Housing Act (42 U.S.C.

10 3601 et seq.) is amended—

(1) in section 802 (42 U.S.C. 3602), by adding
 at the end the following:

3 "(p) 'Source of income' includes—

4 "(1) a housing voucher under section 8 of the
5 United States Housing Act of 1937 (42 U.S.C.
6 1437f) and any form of Federal, State, or local
7 housing assistance provided to a family or provided
8 to a housing owner on behalf of a family, including
9 rental vouchers, rental assistance, and rental sub10 sidies from nongovernmental organizations;

"(2) income received during a taxable year as
Social Security benefits, as defined in section 86(d)
of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or as supplemental security income benefits under title XVI of
the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1381 et seq.);

16 "(3) income received by court order, including17 spousal support and child support;

18 "(4) any payment from a trust, guardian, or19 conservator; and

20 "(5) any other lawful source of income.

21 "(q) 'Veteran status' means—

"(1) a member of the uniformed services, as defined in section 101 of title 10, United States Code;
or

1	"(2) a veteran, as defined in section 101 of title
2	38, United States Code.";
3	(2) in section 804 (42 U.S.C. 3604)—
4	(A) by inserting "source of income, veteran
5	status," after "familial status," each place that
6	term appears; and
7	(B) in subsection (c)—
8	(i) by inserting "(1)" before "To
9	make''; and
10	(ii) by adding at the end the fol-
11	lowing:
12	"(2) Nothing in this title shall be construed to—
13	"(A) prohibit a lender from implementing a
14	loan program for veterans or based upon veteran
15	status; or
16	"(B) prohibit an entity from providing housing
17	assistance under section $8(0)(19)$ of the United
18	States Housing Act of 1937 (42 U.S.C.
19	1437f(o)(19)), the Homeless Providers Grant and
20	Per Diem program of the Department of Veterans
21	Affairs, or any other Federal housing assistance pro-
22	gram for veterans or based upon veterans status.";
23	(3) in section 805 (42 U.S.C. 3605)—

1	(A) in subsection (a), by inserting "source
2	of income, veteran status," after "familial sta-
3	tus,"; and
4	(B) in subsection (c), by inserting "source
5	of income, veteran status," after "handicap,";
6	(4) in section 806 (42 U.S.C. 3606), by insert-
7	ing "source of income, veteran status," after "famil-
8	ial status,"; and
9	(5) in section 808(e)(6) (42 U.S.C. 3608(e)(6)),
10	by inserting "source of income, veteran status,"
11	after "handicap,".
12	(b) Prevention of Intimidation in Fair Hous-
13	ING CASES.—Section 901 of the Civil Rights Act of 1968
14	(42 U.S.C. 3631) is amended by inserting "source of in-
15	come (as defined in section 802), veteran status (as de-
16	fined in section 802)," before "or national origin" each
17	place that term appears.
