A BILL

To amend title 5, United States Code, to designate Juneteenth National Independence Day as a legal public holiday.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Juneteenth National
5 Independence Day Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. JUNETEENTH NATIONAL INDEPENDENCE DAY AS A**
2 **LEGAL PUBLIC HOLIDAY.**

3 Section 6103(a) of title 5, United States Code, is
4 amended by inserting after the item relating to Memorial
5 Day the following:

6 “Juneteenth National Independence Day, June
7 19.”.
