A BILL

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Emergency Supply
- 5 Chain Transparency Act".

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1 SEC. 2. DEFENSE PRODUCTION ACT OF 1950.

2 Title VII of the Defense Production Act of 1950 (50
3 U.S.C. 4551 et seq.) is amended by adding at the end
4 the following:

5 "SEC. 724. ACCOUNTABILITY AND TRANSPARENCY REPORT
6 TO CONGRESS.

7 "(a) IN GENERAL.—Within 14 days of exercising any
8 authority provided under title I or title III of this Act,
9 the President, or the head of each Federal agency to which
10 the President delegates authority under such title, shall
11 issue a report to Congress disclosing—

"(1) the production, transport, distribution,
sale, delivery, and construction of all materials, services, and facilities related to the exercise of such authority; and

16 "(2) any private entity in receipt or possession
17 of such materials, services, and facilities.

18 "(b) UPDATE.—Each report made under subsection
19 (a) shall be updated periodically, not less than every 14
20 days, while such authority is in use.".

21 SEC. 3. FEDERAL EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE.

Section 502 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief
and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5192) is
amended by adding at the end the following:

25 "(d) Report to Congress.—

"(1) IN GENERAL.—Within 14 days of exer-1 2 cising authority under subsection (a), the President, 3 or the head of each Federal agency to which the President delegates authority under this section, 4 5 shall submit to Congress a report disclosing all equipment, supplies, facilities, personnel, services, 6 7 and other resources provided to Federal agencies, private organizations, and State and local govern-8 9 ments under this Act related to such exercise of authority. 10

11 "(2) UPDATE.—Each report made under sub12 section (a) shall be updated periodically, not less
13 than every 14 days, while such authority is in use.".

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
