# A BILL

### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Stop Foreign Dona-
- 5 tions Affecting Our Elections Act".

# SEC. 2. REQUIRING DISCLOSURE OF CREDIT VERIFICATION VALUE AS CONDITION OF ACCEPTANCE OF ONLINE CONTRIBUTIONS TO FEDERAL ELEC TION.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 302 of the Federal Elec6 tion Campaign Act of 1971 (52 U.S.C. 30102) is amended
7 by adding at the end the following:

8 "(j)(1) No political committee shall accept any Inter-9 net credit card contribution unless—

"(A) the individual or entity making such contribution is required, at the time such individual
makes such contribution, to disclose the credit
verification value of such credit card; and

14 "(B)(i) the billing address associated with such15 credit card is located in the United States; or

"(ii) in the case of a contribution made by an
individual who is a United States citizen living outside of the United States, the individual provides the
committee with the United States mailing address
the individual uses for voter registration purposes.

21 "(2) Notwithstanding subsection (b) or (c), in the22 case of an Internet credit card contribution—

23 "(A) no later than 10 days after receiving the
24 contribution, the person who receives the contribu25 tion shall forward to the treasurer such contribution,

1	the name and address of the person making the con-
2	tribution, and the date of receipt; and
3	"(B) the treasurer of a political committee shall
4	keep an account of the name and address of any
5	person making any such contribution, together with
6	the date and amount of such contribution by any
7	person.
8	"(3) In this subsection, the term 'Internet credit card
9	contribution' means a contribution that—
10	"(A) is made using a credit card; and
11	"(B) is received through an Internet website.".
12	(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
13	subsection (a) shall apply with respect to contributions
14	made after the expiration of the 180-day period which be-
15	gins on the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
