7 tember 6, 2021” and inserting “May 31, 2021”.

1 (b) AMOUNT.—Section 2104(b)(3)(A)(ii) of such Act
2 (15 U.S.C. 9023(b)(3)(A)(ii)) is amended by striking
3 “September 6, 2021” and inserting “May 31, 2021”.
