2 81-526, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to eliminate
3 condemnation authority of the State Fire Marshal; to harmonize
4 provisions; to repeal the original section; and to outright repeal
5 sections 81-513, 81-514, 81-515, 81-516, 81-517, 81-518, and 81-519,
6 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska.
7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 81-526, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
2 amended to read:

3 81-526 The county attorney of any county, upon request of the State
4 Fire Marshal, or his or her deputies or assistants, shall (1) assist such
5 officers in the investigation of any fire which, in their opinion, is of
6 suspicious origin and (2) act as attorney for such officers in all court
7 proceedings in connection with the enforcement of ~~sections 81-513 to~~
8 ~~81-519~~ and the Petroleum Products and Hazardous Substances Storage and
9 Handling Act when, in the exercise of a reasonable discretion, the county
10 attorney shall determine that the evidence is sufficient to justify the
11 bringing of such court proceedings.

12 Sec. 2. Original section 81-526, Reissue Revised Statutes of
13 Nebraska, is repealed.

14 Sec. 3. The following sections are outright repealed: Sections
15 81-513, 81-514, 81-515, 81-516, 81-517, 81-518, and 81-519, Reissue
16 Revised Statutes of Nebraska.
