An Act relative to the Baker Hill Road District.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to make certain changes in law in response to a public health emergency, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, clause (a ½) of section 2 of  
2   chapter 41 of the acts of 1989, as amended by chapter 47 of the acts of 2018, shall not be in  
3   effect until 90 days following the conclusion of the state of emergency concerning the novel  
4   coronavirus disease outbreak declared by the governor on March 10, 2020.
