A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Code Section 35-5-7 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to security police force within the Georgia Public Safety Training Center, so as to provide that any member of the security police force, upon his or her retirement or upon leaving such employment as a result of a disability arising in the line of duty, shall be entitled to retain his or her weapon and badge under certain conditions; to provide for rules and regulations; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.** 9 Code Section 35-5-7 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to security police 10 force within the Georgia Public Safety Training Center, is amended by adding a new 11 subsection to read as follows: 12 "(c) Any member of such security police force, upon retirement from employment by the 13 center or upon leaving such employment as a result of a disability arising in the line of 14 duty, shall be entitled, as part of his or her compensation, to retain his or her weapon and 15 badge; provided, however, that such member retires or leaves under honorable conditions. The board shall promulgate rules and regulations for the implementation of this 16 subsection." 17
