To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 321 South 1st Street in Montrose, Colorado, as the "Sergeant David Kinterknecht Post Office".

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SERGEANT DAVID KINTERKNECHT POST OF-
- 4 FICE.
- 5 (a) Designation.—The facility of the United States
- 6 Postal Service located at 321 South 1st Street in
- 7 Montrose, Colorado, shall be known and designated as the
- 8 "Sergeant David Kinterknecht Post Office".

- 1 (b) References.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
- 2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
- 3 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
- 4 be deemed to be a reference to the "Sergeant David
- 5 Kinterknecht Post Office".
- 6 (c) Repeal of Previous Designation.—Section 1
- 7 of Public Law 115–366 is hereby repealed, and the des-
- 8 ignation made and references deemed in subsections (a)
- 9 and (b), respectively, of such section shall have no force
- 10 or effect.
