## A BILL

To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 321 South 1st Street in Montrose, Colorado, as the “Sergeant David Kinterknecht Post Office”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SERGEANT DAVID KINTERKNECHT POST OF-**  
4 **FICE.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States  
6 Postal Service located at 321 South 1st Street in  
7 Montrose, Colorado, shall be known and designated as the  
8 “Sergeant David Kinterknecht Post Office”.

1       (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
2   ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United  
3   States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall  
4   be deemed to be a reference to the “Sergeant David  
5   Kinterknecht Post Office”.

6       (c) REPEAL OF PREVIOUS DESIGNATION.—Section 1  
7   of Public Law 115–366 is hereby repealed, and the des-  
8   ignation made and references deemed in subsections (a)  
9   and (b), respectively, of such section shall have no force  
10   or effect.
