3 ESTABLISHING A STUDY COMMISSION ON THE OPERATION AND
4 FUNDING OF THE SURFACE MINING COMMISSION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF
5 LABOR, ABANDONED MINE PROGRAM.

7 WHEREAS, a comprehensive study of the operation and 8 funding of the Surface Mining Commission and the Department of 9 Labor, Abandoned Mine Program would assist the Legislature in 10 making equitable, meaningful, and effective policy changes for 11 the enhancement of the industry and the economy of this state; 12 now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That there is created the Study Commission on the Operation and Funding of the Surface Mining Commission and the Department of Labor, Abandoned Mine Program.

18 (a) The membership of the commission shall consist19 of the following:

20 (1) Two members of the House of Representatives21 appointed by the Speaker.

(2) Two members of the Senate appointed by thePresident Pro Tempore.

(3) One representative of the coal industry 1 appointed by the member appointed by the Speaker of the House 2 3 of Representatives. 4 (4) One representative of the coal industry appointed by the member appointed by the President Pro Tempore 5 6 of the Senate. 7 (5) One representative of the Department of Labor. 8 (6) One representative of the Surface Mining 9 Commission. 10 (b) The appointing authorities shall coordinate 11 their appointments to assure that the membership of the Study 12 Commission on the Operation and Funding of the Surface Mining 13 Commission and the Department of Labor, Abandoned Mine Program is inclusive and reflects the racial, gender, geographic, 14 15 urban, rural, and economic diversity of the state. (c) The commission shall have all of the following 16 duties: 17 18 (1) Perform a complete and comprehensive review and 19 assessment of state laws and regulations regarding the 20 operation and funding of the Surface Mining Commission and the 21 Department of Labor, Abandoned Mine Program, including any 22 statistical data available. 23 (2) Identify issues in the law or administrative

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24 rules that open gaps or create problems regarding the
25 operation and funding process.

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(3) Identify problem areas, programs, and cost
 efficiencies through systematic data collection and analysis.

3 (4) Identify innovative programs and strategies used
4 in other states that have proven to be effective or have shown
5 promise to improve the operation and funding process in this
6 industry.

7 (5) Submit recommendations for legislative actions 8 to the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the 9 President Pro Tempore of the Senate during the first week of 10 the 2018 Regular Session at which time the commission shall be 11 dissolved.

(d) (1) Appointments to the commission shall be made
within 30 days after the effective date of this act.

14 (2) The commission shall hold its first meeting no
15 later than August 1, 2017, with the date, time, and location
16 of the meeting designated by the Speaker of the House of
17 Representatives.

18 (3) At the first meeting, the commission shall elect
19 a chair, vice chair, and other officers as determined by the
20 commission, and shall set dates, times, and locations of
21 subsequent meetings.

(e) The House of Representatives and the Senate
shall provide the necessary staff and support to the
commission to perform its duties.

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1 (f) Members of the commission shall serve without compensation but may be reimbursed for necessary expenses in 2 attending meetings of the commission according to the policies 3 and procedures of their respective appointing authority. 4 (g) Legislative members of the commission shall be 5 6 entitled to their legislative compensation, per diem, and travel expenses for each day they attend a meeting of the 7 commission in accordance with Amendment 871 of the 8 9 Constitution of Alabama of 1901. (h) A copy of this resolution shall be provided to 10 11 all appointing authorities of the commission.
