AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to crime and punishment; providing for a definition of victimless crime; providing for a definition of a victim; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 20.5 of Title 21, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. A "victimless crime" occurs when there is a criminal act that has no direct victim and involves only the perpetrator or occurs between consenting adults.

B. A "victim" is a person harmed or aggrieved by a crime committed.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
