A BILL

To reallocate funding originally appropriated for Gaza to grants to Israel for the Iron Dome short-range rocket defense system.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Emergency Resupply
- 5 for Iron Dome Act of 2023".

SEC. 2. FUNDING FOR IRON DOME SHORT-RANGE ROCKET 2 DEFENSE SYSTEM. 3 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, including 4 section 1659 of the James M. Inhofe National Defense 5 Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2023 (Public Law 117– 263) and sections 482(b) and 531(e) of the Foreign As-6 7 sistance Act of 1961 (22 U.S.C. 2291a(b) and 2346(e)), 8 the President shall transfer all unexpended balances of ap-9 propriations made available for assistance to Gaza— 10 (1) to the Department of Defense, to be available for grants to Israel for the Iron Dome short-11 12 range rocket defense system; or 13 (2) to the Foreign Military Financing Program authorized under section 23 of the Arms Export 14 Control Act (22 U.S.C. 2763), to be available for 15 16 grants to Israel for the Iron Dome short-range rock-17 et defense system.
