A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 1 of Article 3 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to wiretapping, eavesdropping, surveillance, and related offenses, so as
- 3 to prohibit the use of a device to film underneath a person's clothing under certain
- 4 circumstances; to provide for definitions; to provide for exceptions; to provide for related
- 5 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Part 1 of Article 3 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 9 relating to wiretapping, eavesdropping, surveillance, and related offenses, is amended by
- 10 adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 11 "<u>16-11-61.1.</u>
- 12 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- (1) 'Device' means an instrument or apparatus used for observing, photographing,
- videotaping, recording, or transmitting visual images, including but not limited to a
- camera, photographic equipment, video equipment, mobile phone, or other similar
- 16 <u>equipment.</u>
- 17 (2) 'Intimate parts' shall have the same meaning as set forth in Code Section 16-6-22.1.
- 18 (3) 'Person' means an individual who is 16 years of age or older.
- 19 (b)(1) Notwithstanding Code Section 16-11-90, it shall be unlawful for any individual
- 20 <u>to, knowingly and without the consent of the person observed, use or install a device for</u>
- 21 <u>the purpose of surreptitiously observing, photographing, videotaping, filming, or video</u>
- 22 recording such person underneath such person's clothing, for the purpose of viewing the
- 23 <u>intimate parts of the body of or the undergarments worn by such person, under</u>
- 24 <u>circumstances in which such person has a reasonable expectation of privacy.</u>
- 25 (2) It shall be unlawful to disseminate any image or recording with knowledge that it was
- 26 <u>taken or obtained in violation of paragraph (1) of this subsection.</u>

- 28 (1) The lawful activities of law enforcement and prosecution agencies; or
- 29 (2) A business's or entity's surveillance device used in the ordinary course of its business,
- 30 provided that signage conspicuously warns of such surveillance and the use of such
- 31 <u>device is primarily designed to detect unlawful activity.</u>
- 32 (d) Any violation of this Code section shall constitute a separate offense and shall not
- 33 merge with any other crimes set forth in this title."

35 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
