A BILL

- To make available the continued use of Pick-Sloan Missouri Basin Program project use power by the Kinsey Irrigation Company and the Sidney Water Users Irrigation District, and for other purposes.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1	SECTION 1. CONTINUED USE OF PICK-SLOAN MISSOURI
2	BASIN PROGRAM PROJECT USE POWER BY
3	THE KINSEY IRRIGATION COMPANY AND THE
4	SIDNEY WATER USERS IRRIGATION DISTRICT.
5	(a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds that—
6	(1) the Act of May 18, 1938 (52 Stat. 403,
7	chapter 250; 16 U.S.C. 833 et seq.), authorized the
8	completion, maintenance, and operation of the Fort
9	Peek project;
10	(2) section 2 of that Act (52 Stat. 404, chapter
11	250; 16 U.S.C. 833a) authorized and directed the
12	Bureau of Reclamation—
13	(A) to transmit and sell electric energy
14	generated by the Fort Peek project; and
15	(B) "to interconnect the Fort Peek project
16	with either private or with other Federal
17	projects and publicly owned power systems now
18	or hereafter constructed.";
19	(3) section 9 of the Act of December 22, 1944
20	(commonly known as the "Flood Control Act of
21	1944'') (58 Stat. 891, chapter 665)
22	(A) authorized the Missouri River Basin
23	Project, now known as the "Pick-Sloan Mis-
24	souri Basin Program" (referred to in this see-
25	tion as the "Program");

1	(B) approved the comprehensive plan for
2	the Program set forth in Senate Document 191
3	and House Document 475, as revised and co-
4	ordinated by Senate Document 247, 78th Con-
5	gress;
6	(C) established a permanent administra-
7	tion for the development of the Missouri River
8	Basin; and
9	(D) incorporated the Fort Peek project as
10	part of the Program;
11	(4) in 1946, the Bureau of Reclamation entered
12	into project use power contracts to provide the
13	Kinsey Irrigation Company and the predecessor of
14	the Sidney Water Users Irrigation District electrical
15	service under the authority of the Act of May 18,
16	1938 (52 Stat. 403, chapter 250; 16 U.S.C. 833 et
17	seq.);
18	(5) since 1946, the Bureau of Reclamation has
19	approved 9 modifications to the project use power
20	contracts between the Bureau of Reclamation, the
21	Kinsey Irrigation Company, and the Sidney Water
22	Users Irrigation District;
23	(6) the project use power contracts in effect on
24	the date of enactment of this Act provide electric
25	service to the Kinsey Irrigation Company and the

Sidney Water Users Irrigation District at the Pro gram rate of 2.5 mills per kilowatt-hour, including
wheeling, through 2020; and

4 (7) the Kinsey Irrigation Company and the Sid-5 ney Water Users Irrigation District have reasonably 6 relied on the authority of the Act of May 18, 1938 7 (52 Stat. 403, chapter 250; 16 U.S.C. 833 et seq.), 8 and the fact that the Bureau of Reelamation has 9 treated the Kinsey Irrigation Company and the Sid-10 ney Water Users Irrigation District as irrigation 11 pumping units of the Program for more than 74 12 years.

13 (b) AUTHORIZATION.—Notwithstanding any other provision of law and subject to subsection (c), the See-14 retary of the Interior (acting through the Commissioner 15 of Reclamation) shall continue to treat the irrigation 16 pumping units known as the "Kinsey Irrigation Com-17 pany" in Custer County, Montana and the "Sidney Water 18 Users Irrigation District" in Richland County, Montana, 19 20 or any successor to the Kinsey Irrigation Company or Sid-21 ney Water Users Irrigation District, as irrigation pumping 22 units of the Program for the purposes of wheeling, administration, and payment of project use power. 23

24 (c) LIMITATION.—The quantity of power to be pro-25 vided to the Kinsey Irrigation Company and the Sidney

Water Users Irrigation District (including any successor 1 to the Kinsey Irrigation Company or the Sidney Water 2 3 Users Irrigation District) under subsection (b) may not 4 exceed the maximum quantity of power provided to the 5 Kinsey Irrigation Company and the Sidney Water Users Irrigation District under the applicable contract for elec-6 7 trie service in effect on the date of enactment of this Act. 8 SECTION 1. CONTINUED USE OF PICK-SLOAN MISSOURI 9 BASIN PROGRAM PROJECT USE POWER BY 10 THE KINSEY IRRIGATION COMPANY AND THE 11 SIDNEY WATER USERS IRRIGATION DISTRICT.

12 AUTHORIZATION.—Notwithstanding any other (a)13 provision of law and subject to subsection (b), the Secretary of the Interior (acting through the Commissioner of Rec-14 15 lamation) shall continue to treat the irrigation pumping units known as the "Kinsey Irrigation Company" in Custer 16 County, Montana and the "Sidney Water Users Irrigation 17 District" in Richland County, Montana, or any successor 18 to the Kinsey Irrigation Company or Sidney Water Users 19 Irrigation District, as irrigation pumping units of the 20 21 Pick-Sloan Missouri Basin Program for the purposes of 22 wheeling, administration, and payment of project use 23 power, including the applicability of provisions relating to 24 the treatment of costs beyond the ability to pay under sec-25 tion 9 of the Act of December 22, 1944 (commonly known

as the "Flood Control Act of 1944") (58 Stat. 891, chapter
665).

3 (b) LIMITATION.—The quantity of power to be provided to the Kinsey Irrigation Company and the Sidney 4 5 Water Users Irrigation District (including any successor to the Kinsey Irrigation Company or the Sidney Water Users 6 7 Irrigation District) under subsection (a) may not exceed the maximum quantity of power provided to the Kinsey Irriga-8 tion Company and the Sidney Water Users Irrigation Dis-9 trict under the applicable contract for electric service in ef-10 11 fect on the date of enactment of this Act.
