2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:	
3	→ Section 1. KRS 117.383 is amended to read as follows:	
4	The State Board of Elections shall <u>promulgate administrative</u> [prescribe rules and]	
5	regulations under KRS Chapter 13A which shall which shall include but not be limited	
6	to the following:	
7	(1) Achieve and] maintain the maximum degree of correctness, impartiality, and

9	<u>(1)</u> [(2)]	Count, tabulate, and record votes;
10	<u>(2)[(3)]</u>	<u>Place</u> [Establish a method for placing] items on <u>any ballot</u> [the electronic
11	voting device,] which shall, as closely as possible, follow the requirements	
12	pertaining to <u>ballots[ballot labels];</u>	
13	<u>(3)</u> [(4)]	Design the <u>ballots to include a</u> [ballot cards, including a numerical] system to
14	ensure[insure] an accurate record of all voting activities;	
15	<u>(4)</u> [(5)]	Instruct voters in the use of the voting equipment and any ballot marking
16	device;	
17	<u>(5)</u> [(6)]	Provide for checking the accuracy of the <i>voting</i> equipment;
18	<u>(6)</u> [(7)]	Provide necessary supplies, including those necessary for a write-in vote, and
19	secrecy envelopes for punch cards or data processing cards] to ensure[insure] voter	
20	privacy;	
21	<u>(7)</u> [(8)]	As part of the official canvass, provide for a manual recount of randomly
22	selected precincts representing three percent (3%) to five percent (5%) of the total	
23	ballots cast in each election;	
24	<u>(8)<del>[</del>(9)]</u>	Provide[ a method] for maintaining sufficient documents and records so that
25	votes can be recounted: [. Such documents and records shall include any material	
26	other than a ballot card which is imprinted with the names of candidates and issues	
27	voted upon. Records shall be maintained in such a manner that a specific piece of

1	printed material listing issues and candidates can be matched with the specific ballot	
2	cards which were marked in reliance upon such printed material.]	
3	(9) Develop a procedure audit program that evaluates the procedures of an election	
4	to determine how well an election was conducted by reviewing:	
5	(a) The voter registration procedures, including:	
6	1. Proper use of voter registration forms;	
7	2. Entry of data into the statewide voter registration file;	
8	3. Proper use of forms: and	
9	4. Ability of existing procedures to accurately determine eligibility of	
10	registrants;	
11	(b) The proper use and operation of any electronic systems;	
12	(c) The compliance with federal and state requirements; and	
13	(d) Absentee voting requirements and procedures;	
14	(10) Develop a procedure for a post-election audit program that evaluates the	
15	accuracy and security of any voting system in operation in this state; and	
16	(11) Except as otherwise required in this chapter that certain records and papers relating	
17	to specified elections be retained for twenty-two (22) months, provide that all	
18	other[such] documents and records shall be maintained for a minimum of thirty	
19	(30) days following an election.
