BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

| Section 1. (A) There is hereby created the Regional | 5 |
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| Economic Development Alliance Study Committee. The Committee | 6 |
| shall consist of the following members: | 7 |
| (1) Three members of the House of Representatives, not | 8 |
| more than two of whom are members of the same party, appointed | 9 |
| by the Speaker of the House of Representatives; | 10 |
| (2) Three members of the Senate, not more than two of whom | 11 |
| are members of the same party, appointed by the President of the | 12 |
| Senate; | 13 |
| (3) The Governor, or the Governor's designee; | 14 |
| (4) Two representatives from academia engaged in relevant | 15 |

(B) The Committee shall study the features, benefits, and
challenges involved in establishing regional economic
development alliances that would enhance collaboration for
successful regional economic development efforts, allow for the
sharing of services, and permit the mobilization of necessary
resources among alliance members. The Committee shall also
examine the ways in which such alliances would address the needs
of regions throughout the state.

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In completing its study, the Committee shall consult with 43 various resource groups, including county commissioners, 44
