A BILL

To amend title 40, United States Code, to promote regional economic and infrastructure development, and for other purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. 4 This Act may be cited as the "Northern Border Regional Commission Reauthorization Act of 2018". SEC. 2. ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES OF REGIONAL COMMIS-7 SIONS. 8 Section 15304(c)(3)(A) of title 40, United States Code, is amended by striking "unanimous" and inserting "major-10 ity". SEC. 3. ECONOMIC AND INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT 12 GRANTS. 13 Section 15501 of title 40, United States Code, is amended— 14 15 (1) in subsection (b) by striking "paragraphs (1) 16 through (3)" and inserting "paragraph (1), (2), (3), 17 or (7)"; and 18 (2) in subsection (f) by striking the period at the 19 end and inserting ", except that financial assistance 20 may be used as otherwise authorized by this subtitle 21 to attract businesses to the region from outside the 22 United States.". SEC. 4. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS. 24 Section 15751(a) of title 40, United States Code, is amended by striking "2018" and inserting "2023".

1 SEC. 5. TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS.

- 2 Chapters 1, 2, 3, and 4 of subtitle V of title 40, United
- 3 States Code, are redesignated as chapters 151, 153, 155, and
- 4 157, respectively.
- 5 SEC. 6. VACANCIES.
- 6 Section 15301 of title 40, United States Code, is
- 7 amended by adding at the end the following:
- 8 "(f) Succession.—Subject to the time limitations set
- 9 forth in section 3346 of title 5, United States Code, the Fed-
- 10 eral Cochairperson may designate a Federal employee of the
- 11 Commission to perform the functions and duties of the office
- 12 of the Federal Cochairperson temporarily in an acting ca-
- 13 pacity if both the Federal Cochairperson and the alternate
- 14 Federal Cochairperson die, resign, or otherwise are unable
- 15 to perform the functions and duties of their offices.".
