## **A BILL**

# FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to employment of legislative employees."

# 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- (a) During each session, the rules committee of each house is responsible for approving the hiring of legislative employees for standing, special, and joint committees and caucuses and any legislative employee assigned to an individual member beyond those authorized under (g) of this section. During the interim, any legislative employee beyond those authorized under (g) of this section may be hired only with the approval of the president of the senate or the speaker of the house of
