AN ACT

- To make certain improvements in the educational assistance benefits under the laws administered by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs in the case of changes to courses of education by reason of emergency situations, and for other purposes.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Student Veteran3 Coronavirus Response Act of 2020".

4 SEC. 2. COVERED PERIOD DEFINED.

For purposes of this Act, the term "covered period"
means the period beginning on March 1, 2020, and ending
on December 21, 2020.

8 SEC. 3. PAYMENT OF WORK-STUDY ALLOWANCES DURING 9 EMERGENCY SITUATIONS.

During the covered period, the Secretary of Veterans
Affairs shall apply section 3485 of title 38, United States
Code, as if it were amended by adding at the end the following new subsection:

14 "(f)(1) In case of an individual who is in receipt of 15 work-study allowance pursuant to an agreement described 16 in subsection (a)(3) as of the date on which an emergency 17 situation occurs and who is unable to continue to perform 18 qualifying work-study activities described in subsection 19 (a)(4) by reason of the emergency situation—

"(A) the Secretary may continue to pay workstudy allowance under this section or make deductions described in subsection (e)(1) during the period of such emergency situation, notwithstanding
the inability of the individual to perform such workstudy activities by reason of such emergency situation; and

1 "(B) at the option of the individual, the Sec-2 retary shall extend the agreement described in sub-3 section (a)(3) with the individual for any subsequent 4 period of enrollment initiated during the emergency 5 situation, notwithstanding the inability of the indi-6 vidual to perform work-study activities described in 7 subsection (a)(4) by reason of such emergency situa-8 tion.

9 "(2) The amount of work-study allowance payable to 10 an individual under paragraph (1)(A) during the period 11 of an emergency situation shall be an amount determined 12 by the Secretary but may not exceed the amount that 13 would be payable under subsection (a)(2) if the individual 14 worked 25 hours per week paid during such period.".

15 SEC. 4. PAYMENT OF ALLOWANCES TO VETERANS EN-16ROLLED IN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS17CLOSED FOR EMERGENCY SITUATIONS.

(a) IN GENERAL.—During the covered period, the
Secretary may pay allowances to an eligible veteran or eligible person under section 3680(a)(2)(A) of title 38,
United States Code, if the veteran or person is enrolled
in a program or course of education that—

(1) is provided by an educational institution
that is closed by reason of an emergency situation;
or

(2) is suspended by reason of an emergency sit uation.

3 (b) AMOUNT OF ALLOWANCE.—The total number of
4 weeks for which allowances may be paid under this section
5 may not exceed four weeks.

6 (c) NOT COUNTED FOR PURPOSES OF LIMITA7 TION.—Any amount paid under this section shall not be
8 counted for purposes of the limitation on allowanced under
9 section 3680(a)(2)(A) of title 38, United States Code.

10SEC. 5. PROHIBITION OF CHARGE TO ENTITLEMENT OF11STUDENTS UNABLE TO PURSUE A PROGRAM12OF EDUCATION DUE TO AN EMERGENCY SIT-13UATION.

During the covered period, the Secretary of Veterans
Affairs shall apply section 3699(b)(1) of title 38, United
States Code, as if it were amended—

17 (1) in subparagraph (A), by striking "or" at18 the end;

(2) in subparagraph (B)(ii), by striking "and"
at the end and inserting "or"; and

21 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-22 paragraph:

23 "(C) the temporary closure of an edu24 cational institution or the temporary closure or

1	termination of a course or program of education
2	by reason of an emergency situation; and".
3	SEC. 6. EXTENSION OF TIME LIMITATIONS FOR USE OF EN-
4	TITLEMENT.
5	(a) MONTGOMERY GI BILL.—During the covered pe-
6	riod, the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall apply section
7	3031 of title 38, United States Code, as if it were amend-
8	ed by adding at the end the following new subsection:
9	"(i) In the case of an individual eligible for edu-
10	cational assistance under this chapter who is prevented
11	from pursuing the individual's chosen program of edu-
12	cation before the expiration of the 10-year period for the
13	use of entitlement under this chapter otherwise applicable
14	under this section because the educational institution
15	closed (temporarily or permanently) under an established
16	policy based on an Executive order of the President or
17	due to an emergency situation, such 10-year period—

18 "(1) shall not run during the period the indi19 vidual is so prevented from pursuing such program;
20 and

21 "(2) shall again begin running on the first day
22 after the individual is able to resume pursuit of a
23 program of education with educational assistance
24 under this chapter.".

25 (b) Post-9/11 Educational Assistance.—

1	(1) IN GENERAL.—During the covered period,
2	the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall apply section
3	3321(b)(1) of such title as if it were amended—
4	(A) by inserting "(A)" before "Sub-
5	sections";
6	(B) by striking "and (d)" and inserting
7	"(d), and (i)"; and by adding at the end the fol-
8	lowing new subparagraph:
9	"(B) Subsection (i) of section 3031 (as de-
10	scribed in section 6 of the Student Veteran
11	Coronavirus Response Act of 2020) shall apply with
12	respect to the running of the 15-year period de-
13	scribed in paragraphs $(4)(A)$ and $(5)(A)$ of this sub-
14	section in the same manner as such subsection ap-
15	plies under section 3031 with respect to the running
16	of the 10-year period described in section 3031(a).".
17	(2) TRANSFER PERIOD.—During the covered
18	period, the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall apply
19	section $3319(h)(5)$ of such title as if it were amend-
20	ed—
21	(A) in subparagraph (A) by inserting "or
22	(C)" after "subparagraph (B)"; and
23	(B) by adding at the end the following new
24	subparagraph:

1 "(C) EMERGENCY SITUATIONS.—In any 2 case in which the Secretary determines that an individual to whom entitlement is transferred 3 4 under this section has been prevented from pursuing the individual's chosen program of edu-5 6 cation before the individual attains the age of 7 26 years because the educational institution 8 closed (temporarily or permanently) under an 9 established policy based on an Executive order 10 of the President or due to an emergency situa-11 tion, the Secretary shall extend the period dur-12 ing which the individual may use such entitle-13 ment for a period equal to the number of 14 months that the individual was so prevented 15 from pursuing the program of education, as de-16 termined by the Secretary.". 17 (c) VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION AND TRAINING.—

21 (A) in subsection (a), by striking "or (e)"
22 and inserting "(e), or (g)"; and
23 (B) by adding at the end the following new
24 subsection:

(1) PERIOD FOR USE.—During the covered pe-

riod, the Secretary of Veterans affairs shall apply

section 3103 of such title as if it were amended—

1 "(g) In any case in which the Secretary determines
2 that a veteran has been prevented from participating in
3 a vocational rehabilitation program under this chapter
4 within the twelve-year period of eligibility prescribed in
5 subsection (a) by reason of an Executive order of the
6 President or due to an emergency situation, such twelve7 year period—

8 "(1) shall not run during the period the indi9 vidual is so prevented from participating such pro10 gram; and

"(2) shall again begin running on the first day
after the individual is able to resume participation in
such program.".

14 (2) DURATION OF PROGRAM.—During the cov15 ered period, the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall
16 apply section 3105(b) of such title as if it were
17 amended—

18 (A) in paragraph (1), by striking "para19 graph (2)" and inserting "paragraphs (2) and
20 (3)"; and

21 (B) by adding at the end the following new22 paragraph:

23 "(3)(A) In any case in which the Secretary deter24 mines that a veteran has been prevented from partici25 pating in counseling and placement and postplacement

services described in section 3104(a)(2) and (5) of this 1 2 title by reason of an Executive order of the President or 3 due to an emergency situation, the Secretary shall extend 4 the period during which the Secretary may provide such 5 counseling and placement and postplacement services for the veteran for a period equal to the number of months 6 7 that the veteran was so prevented from participating in 8 such counseling and services, as determined by the Sec-9 retary.

10 "(B) In any case in which the Secretary determines that a veteran has been prevented from participating in 11 12 a vocational rehabilitation program under this chapter by 13 reason of an Executive order of the President or due to an emergency situation, the Secretary shall extend the pe-14 15 riod of the veteran's vocational rehabilitation program for a period equal to the number of months that the veteran 16 was so prevented from participating in the vocational re-17 habilitation program, as determined by the Secretary.". 18

(d) EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE FOR MEMBERS OF
THE SELECTED RESERVE.—During the covered period,
the Secretary concerned shall apply section 16133(b) of
title 10, United States Code, as if it were amended by
adding at the end the following new paragraph:

24 "(5) In any case in which the Secretary concerned25 determines that a person entitled to educational assistance

under this chapter has been prevented from using such
 person's entitlement by reason of an Executive order of
 the President or due to an emergency situation, the Sec retary concerned shall extend the period of entitlement
 prescribed in subsection (a) for a period equal to the num ber of months that the person was so prevented from using
 such entitlement, as determined by the Secretary.".

8 SEC. 7. RESTORATION OF ENTITLEMENT TO REHABILITA9 TION PROGRAMS FOR VETERANS AFFECTED 10 BY SCHOOL CLOSURE OR DISAPPROVAL.

(a) ENTITLEMENT.—During the covered period, the
Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall apply section 3699 of
title 38, United States Code, as if it were amended by
striking "chapter 30," each time it appears and inserting
"chapter 30, 31,".

(b) PAYMENT OF SUBSISTENCE ALLOWANCES.—
During the covered period, the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall apply section 3680(a)(2)(B) of title 38, United
States Code, as if it were amended—

20 (1) by inserting "or a subsistence allowance de21 scribed in section 3108" before ", during"; and

(2) by inserting "or allowance" after "such astipend".

1SEC. 8. EXTENSION OF PAYMENT OF VOCATIONAL REHA-2BILITATION SUBSISTENCE ALLOWANCES.

3 In the case of any veteran whom the Secretary of Veterans Affairs determines is satisfactorily following a pro-4 5 gram of employment services provided under section 3104(a)(5) of title 38, United States Code, during the cov-6 7 ered period, the Secretary may pay the veteran a subsist-8 ence allowance, as prescribed in section 3108 of such title 9 for full-time training for the type of program that the veteran was pursuing, for two additional months. 10

11 SEC. 9. EMERGENCY DESIGNATIONS.

(a) IN GENERAL.—This Act is designated as an
emergency requirement pursuant to section 4(g) of the
Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010 (2 U.S.C. 933(g)).

(b) DESIGNATION IN SENATE.—In the Senate, this
Act is designated as an emergency requirement pursuant
to section 4112(a) of H. Con. Res. 71 (115th Congress),

the concurrent resolution on the budget for fiscal year
 2018.
