A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

То	urge Congress and the President of the United States	1
	to support a federal budget that retains Amtrak	2
	passenger service in Ohio.	3

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF OHIO (THE SENATE CONCURRING):

WHEREAS, The President of the United State's current budget	4		
proposes to end Amtrak passenger train service in Ohio. The	5		
budget proposal calls for all long-distance trains to be			
eliminated so that Amtrak can concentrate on improving the	7		
efficiency of its shorter commuter corridors. Eliminating the	8		
long-distance routes would bring an end to all intercity train	9		
service in approximately 23 states that Amtrak now serves,	10		
including Ohio; and			
WHEREAS, The Ohio routes proposed to be eliminated include	12		
the Lake Shore Limited and Capitol Limited trains that make	13		
daily eastbound and westbound stops in Toledo and Cleveland, and			
the Cardinal train that makes three trips per week each way	15		
through Cincinnati; and			
WHEREAS, Toledo's Amtrak station and all of its	17		
counterparts in Ohio would lose passenger train service as part	18

of the proposed budget. Last year the Amtrak trains passing	19
through the Toledo station served 55,536 people. The proposed	20
budget may constrain Ohioans' options for travel from Toledo and	21
other locations in Ohio and will reduce revenue that currently	22
is used to maintain railroad station facilities, including the	23
Amtrak building in Toledo, which also houses Toledo's Greyhound	24
bus station; now therefore be it	25
RESOLVED, That we, the members of the 132nd General	26
Assembly of the State of Ohio, in adopting this resolution, urge	27
the Congress of the United States to remove provisions of the	28
current proposed federal budget that eliminate funding for	29
Amtrak services in Ohio; and be it further	30
RESOLVED, That we, the members of the 132nd General	31
Assembly of the State of Ohio, urge the President of the United	32
States to support a federal budget that maintains Amtrak	33
passenger train service in Ohio; and be it further	34
RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the House of Representatives	35
transmit duly authenticated copies of this resolution to the	36
President of the United States, the Speaker and Clerk of the	37
United States House of Representatives, the President Pro	38
Tempore and Secretary of the United States Senate, each member	39
of the Ohio Congressional delegation, and the news media of	40
Ohio.	41
