A BILL

To reinstate and extend the deadline for commencement of construction of a hydroelectric project involving Jennings Randolph Dam.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. REINSTATEMENT AND EXTENSION OF TIME 4 FOR A FEDERAL ENERGY REGULATORY COM-5 MISSION PROJECT INVOLVING JENNINGS 6 RANDOLPH DAM. 7 (a) Extension of Time.—Notwithstanding the time 8 period specified in section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) that would otherwise apply to the Federal

- 1 (referred to in this section as the "project"), the Federal
- 2 Energy Regulatory Commission (referred to in this section
- 3 as the "Commission" may, at the request of the licensee
- 4 for the project, and after reasonable notice, in accordance
- 5 with the good faith, due diligence, and public interest re-
- 6 quirements of, and the procedures of the Commission
- 7 under, that section, extend the time period during which
- 8 the licensee is required to commence the construction of
- 9 the project for not more than 3 consecutive 2-year periods
- 10 that begin on the date of the expiration of the extension
- 11 originally issued by the Commission.
- 12 (b) Obligation of Licensee.—Any obligation of
- 13 the licensee for the project for the payment of annual
- 14 charges under section 10(e) of the Federal Power Act (16
- 15 U.S.C. 803(e)) shall commence on the expiration of the
- 16 time period to commence construction of the project, as
- 17 extended by the Commission under subsection (a).
- 18 (c) Reinstatement of Expired License.—
- 19 (1) IN GENERAL.—If the period required for
- the commencement of construction of the project has
- 21 expired before the date of enactment of this Act, the
- Commission may reinstate the license effective as of
- the date of the expiration of the license.
- 24 (2) Extension.—If the Commission reinstates
- 25 the license under paragraph (1), the first extension

- 1 authorized under subsection (a) shall take effect on
- 2 the date of the expiration of the license.
