## A BILL

- To prohibit school food authorities and local educational agencies from collecting unpaid school meal fees during the COVID-19 pandemic, and for other purposes.

### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Suspend School Meal

5 Debt Act of 2020".

#### 6 SEC. 2. SCHOOL MEAL DEBT DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC.

7 (a) DEFINITION OF EMERGENCY PERIOD.—In this
8 section, the term "emergency period" means the period
9 beginning on the date of enactment of this Act and ending

on the date that is 30 days after the date on which the
 public health emergency declared by the Secretary of
 Health and Human Services under section 319 of the Pub lic Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 247d) on January 31,
 2020, with respect to COVID-19 is terminated.

6 DEBT COLLECTION PROHIBITION.—Notwith-(b)7 standing any other provision of law, during the emergency 8 period, a school food authority or a local educational agen-9 cy participating in the school lunch program under the 10 Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act (42 U.S.C. 1751 et seq.) or the school breakfast program under sec-11 12 tion 4 of the Child Nutrition Act of 1966 (42 U.S.C. 13 1773) may not—

14 (1) collect unpaid meal fees (including late fees
15 associated with unpaid meals) under those pro16 grams; or

17 (2) use a debt collector (as defined in section
18 803 of the Consumer Credit Protection Act (15
19 U.S.C. 1692a)) to collect those unpaid meal fees.

(c) CANCELLATION OF MEAL DEBTS.—The Secretary of Agriculture shall reimburse each school food authority and local educational agency participating in a program described in subsection (b) for unpaid meal fees (including late fees associated with unpaid meals) owed to

1 that authority or agency as of the date of enactment of

2 this Act.
