4 \* **Section 1.** AS 22.10.120 is amended to read:

5       **Sec. 22.10.120. Number of judges.** The superior court consists of **45** [43] judges, six  
6 of whom shall be judges in the first judicial district, three of whom shall be judges in the  
7 second judicial district, **28** [26] of whom shall be judges in the third judicial district, and eight  
8 of whom shall be judges in the fourth judicial district. At the time of submitting the names of  
9 nominees to the governor to fill a vacancy on the superior court bench, the judicial council  
10 shall also designate the district in which the appointee is to reside and serve.

11 \* **Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect July 1, 2019.
