## S. 3587

### AN ACT

- To require the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to conduct a study on the accessibility of websites of the Department of Veterans Affairs to individuals with disabilities, and for other purposes.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

#### SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 2 This Act may be cited as the "Department of Vet-
- 3 erans Affairs Website Accessibility Act of 2019".
- 4 SEC. 2. STUDY ON THE ACCESSIBILITY OF WEBSITES OF
- 5 THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS
- 6 TO INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES.
- 7 (a) STUDY.—Not later than 180 days after the date
- 8 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Veterans
- 9 Affairs shall conduct a study of all websites of the Depart-
- 10 ment of Veterans Affairs to determine whether such
- 11 websites are accessible to individuals with disabilities in
- 12 accordance with section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act of
- 13 1973 (29 U.S.C. 794d).
- 14 (b) Report.—Not later than 90 days after com-
- 15 pleting the study under subsection (a), the Secretary shall
- 16 submit to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs of the Sen-
- 17 ate and the Committee on Veterans' Affairs of the House
- 18 of Representatives a report on such study.
- 19 (c) Elements.—The report required by subsection
- 20 (b) shall include the following:
- 21 (1) A list of each website described in sub-
- section (a) that is not accessible to individuals with
- disabilities in accordance with section 508 of the Re-
- 24 habilitation Act of 1973 (29 U.S.C. 794d).
- 25 (2) For each website identified in the list under
- 26 paragraph (1)—

1	(A) the plan of the Secretary to bring the
2	website into compliance with the requirements
3	of section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973
4	(29 U.S.C. 794d); and
5	(B) a description of the barriers to bring-
6	ing the website into compliance with the re-
7	quirements of such section, including any bar-
8	riers relating to vacant positions at the Depart-
9	ment of Veterans Affairs.
10	(d) Website Defined.—In this section, the term
11	"website" includes the following:
12	(1) A file attached to a website.
13	(2) A web-based application.
14	(3) A kiosk at a medical facility of the Depart-
15	ment of Veterans Affairs, the use of which is re-
16	quired to check in for scheduled appointments.
