- 1 Recognizing the Douglas County Film Trail's efforts in promoting tourism and showcasing
- 2 the county's famous film and television sites; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, Douglas County became involved in film industry productions with the local
- 4 filming of *Smokey and the Bandit* in 1976 and since then, 36 television shows and major
- 5 motion pictures, as well as countless commercials and independent projects, have been shot
- 6 in Douglas County; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the Douglas County Film Trail is designed to encourage tourism by highlighting
- 8 numerous areas across the community where popular films and television shows have been
- 9 filmed; and
- 10 WHEREAS, visitors to the Douglas County Film Trail can use digital maps or hard copies
- 11 from the Douglas County Welcome Centers and Film Office to conduct semi-structured,
- 12 self-guided tours of various film sites; and
- WHEREAS, Douglas County Film Trail is designed to leverage the popularity of the film
- 14 industry along with the assets of Douglas County by attracting tourists to the community with
- 15 popular film locations and promoting Douglas County to the film industry as an excellent
- 16 location for new business.

- 18 the members of this body recognize Douglas County Film Trail for its efforts in enhancing
