

That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:





1 TERMS.

- 2 (d) (1) The Governor shall appoint an eligible individual to fill a vacancy 3 during the remainder of the term of office of the individual originally appointed in accordance with subsection (a) of this section.
- 5 (2) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the 6 rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- 7 (e) (1) The Governor may remove a member for misconduct in office, 8 incompetence, or willful neglect of duty.
- 9 (2) The Governor shall give a member who is charged a copy of the charges against the member and, with at least 10 days' notice, an opportunity to be heard publicly in person or by counsel.
- 12 (3) If a member is removed, the Governor shall file with the Office of the Secretary of State a statement of charges against the member and the Governor's findings on the charges.

- In making the appointments, the Governor] **THE BOARD** shall designate a chair from among the members of the Board.
- 18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:
- 19 (a) The term of each member of the Board of License Commissioners for Anne 20 Arundel County, or the member's successor selected to fill a vacancy, who is in office on 21 June 30, 2020, shall expire in 2021.
- 22 (b) The term of each of the first two members of the Board of License 23 Commissioners for Anne Arundel County, or the member's successor selected to fill a 24 vacancy, who is appointed on or after the effective date of this Act shall expire in 2022.
- 25 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 26 1, 2020.
