A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to provide an additional tool to prevent certain frauds against veterans, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Preventing Crimes
- 5 Against Veterans Act of 2023".

1	SEC. 2. ADDITIONAL TOOL TO PREVENT CERTAIN FRAUDS
2	AGAINST VETERANS.
3	(a) In General.—Chapter 63 of title 18, United
4	States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
5	lowing:
6	"§ 1352. Fraud regarding veterans' benefits
7	"(a) Whoever knowingly executes, or attempts to exe-
8	cute, any scheme or artifice to defraud an individual of
9	veterans' benefits, or in connection with obtaining vet-
10	eran's benefits for that individual, shall be fined under this
11	title, imprisoned for not more than 5 years, or both.
12	"(b) In this section—
13	"(1) the term 'veteran' has the meaning given
14	that term in section 101 of title 38; and
15	"(2) the term 'veterans' benefits' means any
16	benefit provided by Federal law for a veteran or a
17	dependent or survivor of a veteran.".
18	(b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
