AN ACT

- To facilitate the automatic acquisition of citizenship for lawful permanent resident children of military and Federal Government personnel residing abroad, and for other purposes.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2	This	Act	may	be	cited	as	the	"Citizenship	o for	Chil-

- 3 dren of Military Members and Civil Servants Act".
- 4 SEC. 2. FACILITATING THE AUTOMATIC ACQUISITION OF
- 5 CITIZENSHIP FOR LAWFUL PERMANENT
- 6 RESIDENT CHILDREN OF MILITARY AND FED-
- 7 ERAL GOVERNMENT PERSONNEL RESIDING
- 8 ABROAD.
- 9 (a) In General.—Section 320 of the Immigration
- 10 and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1431) is amended—
- 11 (1) by striking the section header and inserting
- 12 "CHILDREN BORN OUTSIDE THE UNITED STATES
- 13 AND LAWFULLY ADMITTED FOR PERMANENT RESI-
- 14 DENCE; CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH CITIZENSHIP
- 15 AUTOMATICALLY ACQUIRED";
- 16 (2) by redesignating subsection (c) as sub-
- 17 section (d); and
- 18 (3) by inserting after subsection (b) the fol-
- lowing:
- 20 "(c) Subsection (a)(3) is deemed satisfied in the case
- 21 of a child who is lawfully admitted for permanent resi-
- 22 dence in the United States if—
- 23 "(1) the child is residing in the legal and phys-
- 24 ical custody of a citizen parent who is—

1	"(A) stationed and residing abroad as an
2	employee of the Government of the United
3	States; or
4	"(B) residing abroad in marital union with
5	an employee of the Government of the United
6	States who is stationed abroad; or
7	"(2) the child is—
8	"(A) residing in the legal and physical cus-
9	tody of a citizen parent who is—
10	"(i) stationed and residing abroad as
11	a member of the Armed Forces of the
12	United States; or
13	"(ii) authorized to accompany and re-
14	side abroad with a member of the Armed
15	Forces of the United States pursuant to
16	the member's official orders, and is so ac-
17	companying and residing abroad with the
18	member in marital union; and
19	"(B) authorized to accompany such mem-
20	ber and reside abroad with the member pursu-
21	ant to the member's official orders, and is so
22	accompanying and residing with the member.".
23	(b) Conforming Amendment.—The table of con-
24	tents for the Immigration and Nationality Act is amended

- 1 by striking the item relating to section 320 and inserting
- 2 the following:

"Sec. 320. Children born outside the United States and lawfully admitted for permanent residence; conditions under which citizenship automatically acquired.".

3 SEC. 3. DETERMINATION OF BUDGETARY EFFECTS.

- 4 The budgetary effects of this Act, for the purpose of
- 5 complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010,
- 6 shall be determined by reference to the latest statement
- 7 titled "Budgetary Effects of PAYGO Legislation" for this

- 9 by the Chairman of the House Budget Committee, pro-
- 10 vided that such statement has been submitted prior to the
- 11 vote on passage.
