A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to extend the special expensing rules for certain film, television, and live theatrical productions.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Facilitating Invest-
5 ments in Local Markets Act of 2017” or the “FILM Act
6 of 2017”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF SPECIAL EXPENSING RULES FOR**
2 **CERTAIN FILM, TELEVISION, AND LIVE THE-**
3 **ATRICAL PRODUCTIONS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 181(g) of the Internal
5 Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by striking “December
6 31, 2016” and inserting “December 31, 2018”.

7 (b) EFFECTIVE DATES.—

8 (1) IN GENERAL.—The amendments made by
9 this section apply to productions commencing after
10 December 31, 2016.

11 (2) COMMENCEMENT.—For purposes of para-
12 graph (1), the date on which a qualified live theat-
13 rical production commences is the date of the first
14 public performance of such production for a paying
15 audience.
