7	fee for a Class E "dump service registration" vehicle registered as a Class E "farm

20	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
21	That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

"Farm vehicle" means a vehicle that: 1 (c) 2 Is owned by a farmer; (1) 3 Is used only in the farmer's farming business and about the farmer's 4 farm home and in hauling farm products and the labor, supplies, equipment, and other 5 materials necessary for the operation of the farm and farm home; and 6 Is not used to haul farm products previously acquired by the farmer for 7 resale or to haul farm products for hire for another person who is not a farmer. 8 13-919. 9 On application, the Administration shall issue a special Class E "dump service 10 registration" to any applicant who certifies that the vehicle for which the application is 11 made is a Class E (truck) vehicle that: 12 (1) Is designed to haul cargo and to self-unload by gravity or mechanical 13 means; and Is to be used to haul feed or other loose materials in bulk. 14 (2) 15 13–921. In this section, "farm truck" means a farm vehicle that: 16 (a) 17 (1) (I)Is a Class E (truck) vehicle; and 18 [(2)](II)Has a shipping weight of its chassis and battery, as certified by the manufacturer, of more than 3/4 ton; OR 19 IS A CLASS E (TRUCK) "DUMP SERVICE REGISTRATION" VEHICLE 20 **(2)** 21 WITH FOUR AXLES AND A MAXIMUM GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT LIMITATION OF 70,000 22 POUNDS. 23 On application, the Administration shall issue a Class E "farm truck 24registration" to any applicant who certifies: 25(1) That the applicant is a farmer; and 26 (2)That the vehicle for which the application is made is a farm truck, specifying its proposed use. 27

For each vehicle registered under this section, the annual registration fee is

based on the maximum gross vehicle weight, as follows:

1	Maximum Gross Weight	Fee (per 1,000 Pounds
2	Limit (in Pounds)	or Fraction Thereof)
3	10,000 (minimum) - 40,000	\$5.00
4	40,001 - 65,000 (maximum)	\$5.25
5	70,000 ("DUMP SERVICE" MAXIMUM)	\$5.25

- 6 (d) Except as provided in \S 8–602(c) of this article, a vehicle registered under this 7 section may not be used:
- 8 (1) For hire except to haul farm products for another farmer; or
- 9 (2) In any manner other than as a farm truck.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 October 1, 2020.
