3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Identify Gun Stores5 Act".

SEC. 2. PREEMPTION RELATING TO MERCHANT CATEGORY CODES.

3 Section 5313 of title 31, United States Code, is
4 amended by inserting after subsection (g) the following:
5 "(h) MERCHANT CATEGORY CODE USAGE.—

6 "(1) IN GENERAL.—No State may prohibit or 7 otherwise deter the usage of any merchant category 8 code established by the International Organization 9 for Standardization, including codes that identify 10 firearm merchants and ammunition merchants.

11 "(2) ENFORCEMENT.—The Attorney General
12 may bring a civil action in the appropriate district
13 court to enforce this subsection.".
