2 (a) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section or elsewhere in the 3 Maryland Vehicle Law, each motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, and pole trailer driven on 4 a highway shall be registered under this subtitle.

5 (c) Registration under this subtitle is not required for:

6 (12) A golf cart that is operated on a highway in accordance with § 21–104.2, 7 § 21–104.3, § 21–104.4, [or] § 21–104.6, OR § 21–104.7 of this article;

9 (A) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A PERSON WHO 10 OPERATES A GOLF CART ON A HIGHWAY IN THE TOWN OF CHARLESTOWN, CECIL 11 COUNTY, WITHOUT REGISTRATION AS AUTHORIZED UNDER § 13–402(C)(12) OF THIS 12 ARTICLE:

(1) MAY OPERATE THE GOLF CART ONLY:

14(I)ON A HIGHWAY ON WHICH THE MAXIMUM POSTED SPEED15LIMIT DOES NOT EXCEED 30 MILES PER HOUR; AND

16 (II) IF THE GOLF CART IS EQUIPPED WITH LIGHTING DEVICES 17 AS REQUIRED BY THE ADMINISTRATION;

18 (2) SHALL KEEP THE GOLF CART AS FAR TO THE RIGHT OF THE 19 ROADWAY AS FEASIBLE; AND

(3) SHALL POSSESS A VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE.

(B) THE TOWN COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF CHARLESTOWN MAY
DESIGNATE BY RESOLUTION THE HIGHWAYS IN THE TOWN OF CHARLESTOWN,
CECIL COUNTY, ON WHICH A PERSON MAY OPERATE A GOLF CART.
