2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WILLIAM T. COLEMAN, JR., FEDERAL BUILDING.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The headquarters building of the
5 Department of Transportation located at 1200 New Jer-
6 sey Avenue, SE, in Washington, DC, shall be known and

1 designated as the “William T. Coleman, Jr., Federal
2 Building”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in law, map, regu-
4 lation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the building referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “William T. Coleman,
7 Jr., Federal Building”.

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
