SECTION 1. POLICE OFFICER SCOTT BASHIOUM POST OF-

- 3 (a) Designation.—The facility of the United States
- 4 Postal Service located at 120 West Pike Street in
- 5 Canonsburg, Pennsylvania, shall be known and designated
- 6 as the "Police Officer Scott Bashioum Post Office Build-
- 7 ing".
- 8 (b) References.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
- 9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
- 10 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
- 11 be deemed to be a reference to the "Police Officer Scott
- 12 Bashioum Post Office Building".
